### **Overview**

#### Level Two Learning Programme

The level three Junior Certificate is where students sit exams in June for subjects like English, Geography, Home Economics, where as The Level Two Learning Programme is based around five major Priority Learning Units and a number of short courses.

#### **Priority Learning Units include:**

- Literacy and Communication
- Personal Care
- Prep for Work
- Living in the Community

#### Short courses we cover include:

- Food choice
- Forensic Science
- Caring for Animals
- Horticulture
- History
- French and Irish



This programme is based on continuous assessments and it is assessed by the school, requiring students to have the majority of the learning outcomes achieved. We show our work through pictures on google classroom for parents/guardians to look at what the student is doing in class on a regular basis. We also keep a hard copy of the students work complete in the classroom.

Within this programme students can still complete a number of Level Three subjects all depending on the individual student. For example, some students will be able to complete English, Art and Home Economics Level three and then complete modules from the Level Two Learning Programme. It is individual to each student.
